Title: Firefighter
Reports to: Captains/Lieutenants
Works closely with: All Officers and members
Guidance from: Works under general supervision. A majority of the time is spent working as a team member and acting within limits of the Fire Department Policies and Procedures.

SCOPE

Expected Results/Impacts: To respond to emergency calls for the purpose of suppressing fires, administering first aid, and assisting in other types of emergencies and disasters. To meet the requirements as established in the City's Job Description for Firefighter.

FUNCTIONAL INFORMATION

Essential Functions:

- Responds to fire calls, extinguish or control fires as a member of a team.
- Responds with fire apparatus and may drive and/or operate vehicle.
- Responds to medical emergency calls, performs rescue and first aid as needed.
- Maintains fire apparatus, equipment, and facilities.
- Attends regular training sessions to maintain and upgrade firefighter skills.
- Operates equipment in effective and safe manner.
- Provides community relations on Fire Prevention/Education.

WORKING REQUIREMENTS

Physical Demands: Each applicant/member must be able to perform the physical requirements and job related tasks as outlined by the "Northwest Metro Area Firefighter Physical Standards Job Description Addendum."

Qualifications:

The following subjects shall be completed and passed within the firefighter's probation period:

- Firefighter I Course (NFPA 1001)
- State Certification for Firefighter I

Within two years, complete and pass the following:

- First Responder – Medical
- Driver's Training – CEVO
- Basic Pumping

Within three years, complete and pass the following:

- Firefighter II course (NFPA 1001) or
- Complete three years of in-house training on all Firefighter II subjects
- Haz-Mat Operations level
- State Certification for Firefighter II

Personal Attributes: Present a positive, constructive image and attitude in the performance of their duties.
