- ✓ Over-the-counter medicines
- ✓ Vitamins and supplements
- ✓ Pet medicines

Not accepted

- ✗ No needles, sharps or syringes
- ✗ No medicines from businesses, including healthcare facilities, pharmacies, pharmaceutical representatives, doctors' offices and veterinary clinics

- No ID required

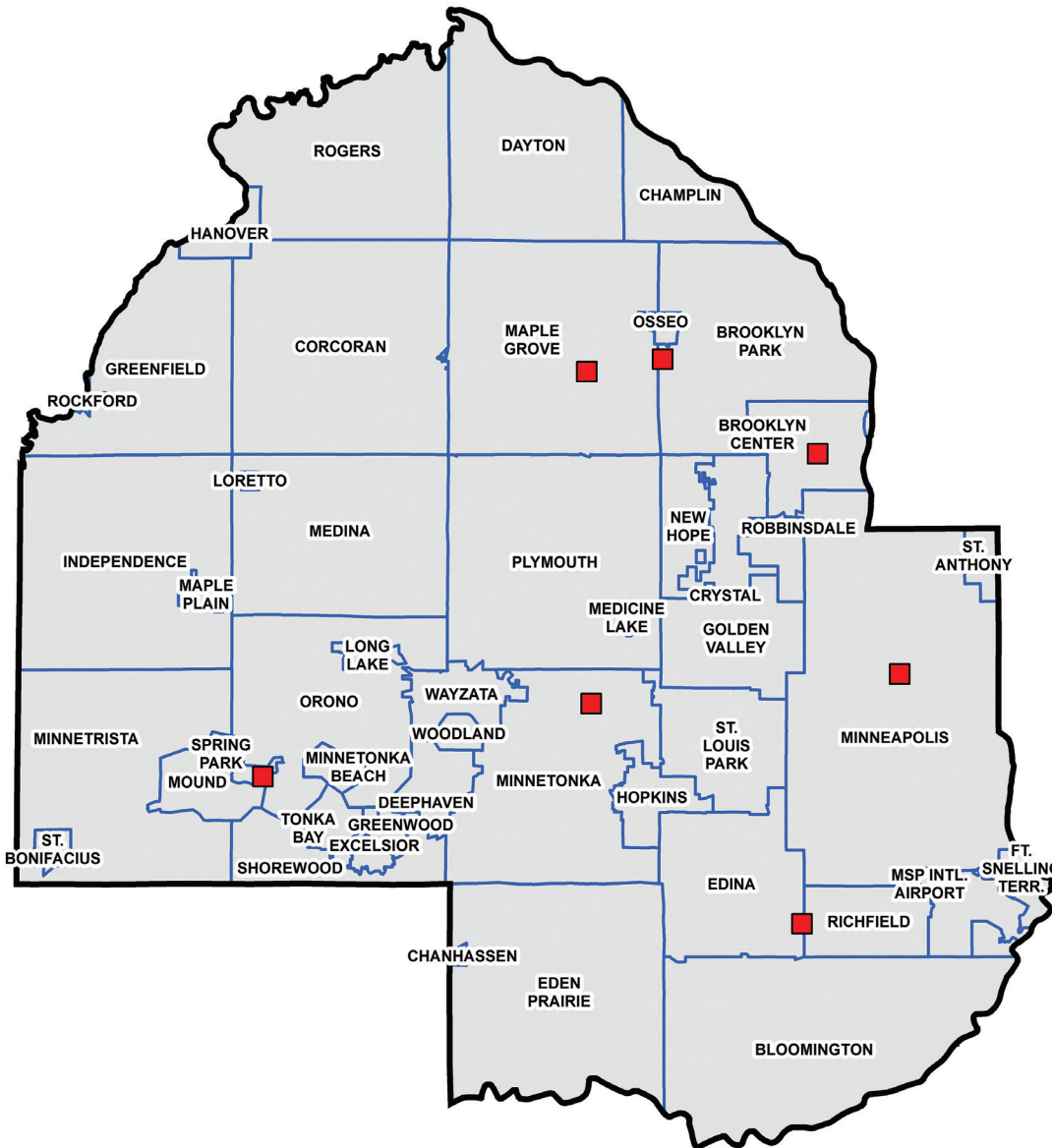
