WATER/SEWER BILLS – City of Osseo 763-424-6752

Meters are electronically read quarterly. (However, final meter readings before you move must be done by a Public Services employee.) Bills are mailed about the 15th day of the months January, April, July, and October, and payments are due about 30 days later. A late penalty of ten percent of the outstanding balance may be assessed if paid after the due date.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING/YARD WASTE COLLECTION – Randy's Sanitation 763-972-3335

Tuesday is garbage/recycling/yard waste day. Items will be picked up at the curb (or alley if you are an alley resident). Please note: alley collection will be picked up FIRST (before curb collection). Make sure all containers are placed by 7:00 a.m.

Garbage: If you are an alley resident, garbage containers must be placed on the east side of the alley for collection.

Recycling: If you are an alley resident, recycling containers must be placed on the west side of the alley for collection. Single sort recycling is every other week and includes items such as aluminum cans, tin cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic milk/water jugs & other plastic bottles with a narrow neck, newspapers/inserts, mail/office/school pages, magazines and catalogs, brown grocery bags, phone books, shredded paper in closed paper bags, cereal/cracker/pasta/cake mix boxes (flattened), shoe boxes/gift boxes/electronic boxes (flattened), and other cardboard. Extra cardboard boxes should be flattened and tied together into bundles no more than three feet long by three feet wide by one foot tall and placed next to the single sort cart. NO plastic bags, Styrofoam, tin foil, light bulbs.

Yard waste: Yard waste collection is from April 1 to approximately November 30 (weather permitting). Yard waste includes bagged grass clippings, leaves, weeds, garden wastes, pinecones, acorns, twigs, and prunings less than four inches in diameter. REMEMBER: Bags must be compostable. Brush/branch clippings less than four inches in diameter should be bundled no more than four feet long and 20 inches in overall diameter.
