- Educational focus on Residential BMPs


Minimum Control Measure 2 Public Participation and Involvement

- City field staff received illicit discharge training

Minimum Control Measure 4 & 5 Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control

Post-Construction Stormwater Management

One (1) active construction sites equal to or greater

- Quarterly Public Works inspections and maintenance
- Public works staff training
- Completed required inspections for stormwater infrastructure:
 - BMP inspections 1
 - Outfall inspections 3
